

Review of: "Perception of Biodiversity versus Connection to Nature: Which Can Influence Wildlife Product Consumption in Vietnam?"

The manuscript "Perception of Biodiveristy versus Connection to Nature: Which Can Influece Wildlife Production Consumption in Vietnam?" is aimed to investigate the relationship among perception of biodiversity (POB), connection to nature (CTN) and wildlife product consumption (WPC) in Vietnam. The topic of the manuscript is quite relevant and interesting for decision makers in Vietnam. However, the current version of the manuscript is rather poorly structured and it is difficult to understand the quality of the results obtained. In my opinion, the authors tried to describe the research hypotheses based on the data available from the Nguyen's dataset and not viceversa.

Some additional key aspects to consider are:

- The paragraph "Literature review and main hypotheses" needs to be completely rewritten because a systematic
 literature review summarized in a Table and described in detail in the text is needed to support your research
 hypotheses. The current version of the paragraph is based solely on a few studies and not on a systematic literature
 review.
- In the "Results" section, the authors should add a sub-paragraph with the description of the socio-demographic characteristics of the sample of respondents (535). Besides, the Figures 3 to 9 are not very significant, they could all be summarized in a single Table.
- The "Discussion" section needs to be rewritten by comparing the results of your study with the international literature for each research hypothesis. In other words, the "Discussion" section must be divided into 4 paragraphs (one for each research hypothesis) and a final paragraph with the Policy implications.

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
