Review of: "Do Not Resuscitate Practices in ICU: A Descriptive Study"

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Thank you for inviting me to review this manuscript. The topic is interesting, and the results are detailed. However, the English in this manuscript is difficult to understand. I would suggest improving the language before submission. For instance, the authors used many long sentences, which made reading difficult. For example, the first sentence of the Results section, "During the study period there were 889 patients discharged from the ICU, of which 168 patients died (including DNR cases), which represents a mortality rate of 18.9%, out of the 168 fatalities, 77 patients had a confirmed DNR order in their medical records," has grammar problems. Additionally, "DNR patients" sounds a bit weird; I couldn't really follow.
