Should elaborate NS—meaning mentioned in table 1

Table 2, What does superscript a, b, c mean?

No need to mention the results data repeatedly and too elaborately in text beneath the results table

Kidney section

Will be Fig 4d instead of 3d.....

Discussion:

In Ref 19 (mention in discussion part), LC50 was done priorly. Then why did you do here again?????

19 a b what does it mean??

Histopathology part...... Not discussed adequately, Should be rewritten

Should correlate: which type of compound may be responsible for such toxicity, as many compounds have already been isolated for this plant.

Conclusion:

May be concluded as......

Not toxic for short term use (from acute toxicity test data), toxic for long term use.
