Moreover, the abstract, which serves as a concise summary of the paper, lacks the key areas of background, methods, results, and conclusions, rendering it ineffective in providing a comprehensive overview of the research. In conclusion, while the paper under review addresses an undoubtedly important topic for the current sustainability landscape, it is not suitable for journal publication in its current form. A rigorous scholarly article demands proper citation, robust argumentation, and a well-structured presentation. Substantial revisions are necessary to elevate this paper to a standard deserving of serious consideration for journal acceptance and publication.

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
