The authors should put in tremendous effort to make the required comments. My comments are listed as follows:

- The whole abstract was not properly structured, and more results should be added.
- The introduction is too short, very poor, and must be much improved and a recent researches should be added.
- Results and discussion section.
- a-) There are several studies reporting similar data but authors offer no comparison with these results (I didn't find any comparison of results with past studies).
- Meaningful conclusions are needed, as conclusions are general and common sense. The conclusion must be reconstructed & simplified into 5-6 main points with supporting results.
- -- The ququalityailty of all figures is very poor and should be improved.
- The recommendations should be added to a separate sub-title after the conclusions.
- The English grammar need careful attention and correction.
