It is better to provide more information about the parameters studied and results obtained.

For example, the author has given- *No significant toxic effects were found in the brain, lung, heart, and liver, as well as in muscles -at the injection site* (page 3/22).

The author can give more information about the parameters analysed and changes that happened in the organs, as well as the extent of changes that happened (say, for example, fold/percentage) in comparison with the control group.
