

Review of: "Raising Adaptive Capacity to Climate Change in Energy and Food Sectors of Egypt"

The paper seems to have the characteristics of a perspective/review article, considering various publications and data sources to address the impacts of climate change on the food and energy sectors and concluding with recommendations. The nature of the study should be explicit already from the abstract, so that even readers unfamiliar with the specific context can orient themselves in the text.

In this case, in addition to a revision of the abstract, which could be made shorter and more concise in identifying schematically the contents of the article, it might be useful to extend section 1. Introduction. In particular, sections 1.1. Aim of the Present Work and 1.3. Data Sources and Methodology could be deepened. In particular, the methodology section could answer questions such as:

How were the sources cited selected?

How many sources are cited?

Where did they come from?

And so on.

In addition, it may be helpful to include a geographical framing of Egypt. Much of the information is already in the text, but it may help to have a paragraph that contextualizes Egypt's geographic location, its climate, its population, and why the food and energy sectors are important.

Regarding section 2. Results and Discussion, it may be appropriate to include summary diagrams or tables that allow a simultaneous reading of all the phenomena considered.

Also, since this is an article analyzing existing studies, it is worthwhile to elaborate on the final comments and recommendations.

On a formal level, I suggest citing sources in all images and re-rendering the most blurred ones.

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
