PRP is a very popular method in recent years. The number of studies on jaw osteonecrosis is quite low. Therefore, I believe that the study will be suitable for publication.

However, there is no explanation about the platelet count obtained from PRP. Although growth factors show the main effectiveness, platelet count is still accepted as an important factor indicating the success of treatment. I think it is necessary to specify the number of platelets obtained from the kit used.
