I was pleased to review your article, and I have some comments:

The title is long. I suggest removing the place of research and the year and including the type of study, for example:

"Prevalence and Associated Factors of Hemorrhoids and Other Perianal Complications During the Puerperium: Cross-sectional Study."

The method of data collection needs to be clarified. The data collection instruments were not described, nor was how the data was collected, since the puerperal women could not read or write.

How did you assess constipation and other perineal problems? What questionnaires were used?

Furthermore, the method by which consent was obtained needs to be corrected. There should have been a representative to sign the consent form.

This study had good associations, but you should have said what statistical tests were used to obtain the results.

This study is critical, especially to create preventive measures and care for these puerperae. Adjust these gaps so as not to lose the results' significance. I also suggest describing the limitations.

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
