

Review of: "What Went So Wrong in Economics"

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The article presents a historical review of the developments and research on the problem of determining the behavior of yields. The introduction and detail around the contributions of different researchers is exhaustive, being especially interesting the section corresponding to the footnotes that complements the content as it is presented.

There is, however, one point where I believe the article could be improved. If it were possible to reorganize it a little, keeping the introduction as it is and presenting the authors' proposals and results in a separate section, I think it would be much clearer for the reader. These results should also be highlighted to a greater extent in the final conclusions.

Otherwise, I consider the article to be very interesting.
