

Review of: "Outcomes of Rezum Water Vapor Therapy for Benign Prostate Obstruction with One-Year Follow-Up: Largest Real-World Data from Türkiye"

The study retrospectively assessed the safety and efficacy of Rezum treatment for BPH in a single center in Turkey. The conclusion is that Rezum therapy is a safe, effective, and minimally invasive option for the treatment of men with moderate to severe lower urinary tract symptoms (LUTS). The conclusions about the efficacy and safety of Rezum are the same as those of previous studies, and the novelty is absent. In addition, the previously published studies included a prospective study, a bigger sample size, and a longer follow-up time, separately.
