Very concise and explicit case report

It wasn't stated if the painful wrist swelling resolved after discontinuation of methotrexate. Was the wrist swelling part of the immunologic drug reaction or RA flare?

Due to the known association of MTX treatment with lymphoproliferative disorders, immunohistochemistry and other molecular tests should have been done on the lymph node sample, including screening for tuberculosis.

- Can you clarify if the wrist swelling resolved after stopping methotrexate, and if it was related to the drug reaction or RA flare?
- Could you suggest specific immunohistochemistry or molecular tests that should be conducted on the lymph node sample to rule out other conditions?
