The following observations should be taken into account if the research is under consideration for submission to scientific journals:

(1) In the research paper, do not use the word (we); there is no need to remind us that you did the research. In fact you are describing an conducted experiment. for example in abstract you say : We employed a Radau, finite-volume method to solve the heat equation in cylindrical coordinates and simulated each material using the best available thermal conductivities, densities, and specific heats.

The correct sentence should be: "The Radau, finite-volume method has been employed to ..... "

(2) Units of measurement must be on a single system(SI- British- French)?? throughout the manuscript.

(3) The introduction part is weak, the introduction to scientific research must include three parts, the first part is a general background on the subject and a prelude to the reader, the second part is a summary of all previous work in the same field and what did they find, the third part is the presentation of the modernity that you added?

(4) The numerical analysis part should include a more detailed explanation of the equations used, if it is only one equation, why not simplify it and do the calculations and results to make it clearer to the reader? Also What is the software used for simulation?

(5) What do you mean by (Xs) ? Should be create a Nomenclature list if any.

(6) References registered with websites and legal authorities, such as the Scopus database, universities, conferences, and official reports, must be cited

(7) You must access the author rules within the journal in which you wish to publish this work, and you must adhere to those rules.

(8) Please carefully consider all comments from reviewers on this paper and ensure they are edited
