

# Review of: "Looking Back on its Fiftieth Year - Bibliometric and Scientometric Analysis of the Articles Published in the Journal of Psychology and Theology from 1996 to 2022"

The article contains a valuable contribution to the Journal of Psychology and Theology, its trajectory and evolution. It shows a solid through-line up to the conclusions.

On the other hand, the analysis of articles received shows the own contributions and the limitation of reception of external articles, but it does not go into it in depth.

I consider valuable the identification of the scope of the journal, since it is international and receives few articles outside the United States.

In the conclusions section, I would suggest writing based on the order of the purposes of the article:

1) identify the most prominent and influential scholars in terms of journals, countries and affiliations, 2) study the co-authorship relationships and collaborative status, 3) analyze the main areas of interest and contribution of the journal, and 4) suggest improvements based on the results.
