It is an extremely complex proposal, with interlevel variables related to each other. Figure 1 can be broken down and explained step by step. There are several submodels within the general model. It is not clear what the response variables are, for example. Simplifying in submodels will help to better understand the idea tested in the regression. Still, the results can be further explored qualitatively, around, for example, the characteristics of society and general culture (power distance, collectivist culture x individualist culture, of Hofstede, for example) of the countries that were the object of analysis.
