Thank you very much for the opportunity to review this manuscript entitled "The Psychological Impact of Leisure and Rehabilitation Activities in Children With Autism: A Delphi Approach," which was submitted for Qeios.

In general, I think that this may be an interesting paper. However, some major concerns should be clarified:

I recommend that a professional native editor edit it.

In the title and abstract sections:

Autism spectrum disorder should be mentioned in the title of the manuscript.

The sampling method is not clear.

The year of the research is not specified.

In the Introduction section:

The introduction is too long and does not convey new information.

The introduction contents do not have the necessary coherence.

The references in the manuscript are very old. A review of recent 3 years' research can be useful.

In the methods section:

How many sessions and how long were the workshops presented?

The population, sample, and sampling method are not reported.

The demographic data of the expert therapists is missing.

The specifications of the questionnaires are missing.

The year of the research is not specified.



Where was the location of this research?

In the discussion section:

At the end of the discussion, the limitations of the research should be stated. Express research suggestions based on limitations.
