A nice descriptive study of what happens with preop SRS. importantly the authors note that 1- they are comparing preoperatively SRS-radiated tissue with primary tissue, not with pre-SRS (i.e. unradiated) tissue. 2- There is a relatively short interval between SRS and resection and thus late immunomodulatory effects aren't assessed. and 3-we can't definitively say what these findings mean at this juncture. But its nice starting data to have.
