Squamous cell carcinoma (SCC) of colon is a rare epithelial tumour of the colon arising from squamous cells of the colorectal epithelium without the presence of squamouslined fistulous tracts or a proximal extension of an anal SCC. It usually presents with nonspecific symptoms, such as anorexia, weight loss, abdominal pain, changes of bowel habits, hematochesia or melena. Cases of severe, symptomatic hypercalcemia have been reported.
