- 6. Please make sure your conclusions section underscores the scientific value added of your paper, and/or the applicability of your findings/results, as indicated previously. Basically, you should enhance your contributions, limitations, underscore the scientific value added of your paper, and/or the applicability of your findings/results, and future study in this section.
- 7. The manuscript would benefit significantly from professional language editing.
