Review of: "Advancing Sentiment Analysis: A Novel LSTM Framework with Multi-head Attention"

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The aim of this paper is to present a new LSTM framework for sentiment analysis.

The quality of the presentation is poor:

- There are problems even in the abstract, for example, sentences such as: "Ablation experiments also support the necessity and the necessity of al modules...."
- In the introduction, the author claims that there are inherent weaknesses in LSTM without presenting details and references and without considering the features of the application domain.
- The dataset is not described with sufficient detail, and the mapping between numbers and tags is not presented.
- The proposed method is presented without introducing the problems of the basic mechanisms and without comparing it with other methods to solve similar issues.
- The method is tested with a single dataset.
- Finally, the conclusions are not supported by the results of the experiment.
