1. I suggest that in the title, not only knowledge but also beliefs and attitudes should be considered, and that the correlational design should be shown in the title in order to better highlight the purpose of the document.
2. Review the brief referencing.
3. I suggest emphasizing in the introduction the importance of knowing not only the knowledge but also the beliefs and attitudes regarding sexual behavior in order to justify the future intervention.
4. Justify the reason for non-probabilistic convenience sampling; specify it in the limitations (not in a generic way).
5. I do not consider it relevant to specify the statistical software used.
6. Discuss the significant differences in both attitudes and knowledge according to the areas of study.
7. Consider in the conclusion how these data contribute to the course or direction of the intervention to be carried out later with the adolescents.

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
