

# Review of: "Impact of entrepreneurial orientation on business performance: Analysis of small-medium sized corn enterprises"

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A very interesting topic to address, however there are several major issues to tackle. In general, this article lacks theoretical and methodological rigour.

The introduction does not define entrepreneurial orientation, which needs to be defined in order to be clear about the phenomenon under study. The introduction should also put more emphasis on the knowledge gap and the main contributions of the study.

Regarding the theoretical framework, this is only a description of a couple of variables and not a literature review to support the study. The Entrepreneurial orientation section lacks theoretical meaning, they have only defined its dimensions, but there is no theoretical discussion regarding this variable.

The section on entrepreneurial performance is unclear and poorly elaborated. They describe the personal performance of a worker and on performance evaluation, it does not correspond.

In relation to the Methodology, it is poorly elaborated and has inconsistencies of substance. In the introduction, it says that it will measure the effect..., and then they do a descriptive study that lacks methodological rigour. They talk about interviews and then surveys, without being clear about the instrument used and the analysis technique. Nor is it clear how they have measured the variables.

In the conclusions section, there are inconsistencies with respect to what was stated in the introduction. How can it be stated that "a high entrepreneurial orientation can improve company performance" with a descriptive study.

There are also errors in the use of quotations. Review the way in which they have been quoted.
