The article presents results in a comprehensible way. I suggest a few improvements:

- This sentence is not really clear and should be revised. A study in Heidelberg (2020), Germany, proved that
 vaccination with 50% effectiveness is almost as effective as vaccination with 100% effectiveness, while all the vaccines
 available in Iran provide at least 60% immunity.
- Potential bias needs to be addressed you mention that participants were recruited from Vaccination centers. Can it be
 that patients with the most severe symptoms of fear were omitted, as they maybe did not even visit vaccination
 centres?
- I would appreciate being able to see all items in the questionnaire so that I can learn more about how self-care variables were measured.
- The introduction is quite long and contains some redundant or extraneous information.
