There are a few aspects to address.

- The introduction feels overly lengthy and detailed, so it would be more effective to condense it. It should focus on highlighting the prevalence and rarity of this condition in relation to existing literature.
- The conclusion should emphasize the study's significance, highlighting its contribution to existing research and the literature. Additionally, it should identify gaps or unresolved questions that future studies should tackle to advance understanding in the field further.
