

Review of: "Exploring the Link Between Climate Change and Farming in Rural and Peri-Urban Communities in Sierra Leone"

I have reviewed the revised version of the article, but the main issues raised in the previous version remain unresolved. The study lacks a climatological analysis and only covers a 10-year period. Furthermore, the article is not adequately supported by observed climate data, aside from mean temperature and annual precipitation. The multivariate regression statistics link perceived yield to the perceived impact of various meteorological parameters, but what exactly does this demonstrate? In my view, it only shows consistency among farmers in their perception of climate change impacts. As in the earlier version, the map and graphs lack essential information (confidence levels, incorrect labels, etc.). Additionally, could you clarify the negative values in the confidence interval percentages in some graphs (e.g., Fig. 3, Fig. 4, and Fig. 10)? As noted in the previous review, I believe the paper, in its current form, is not suitable for publication.
