Review of: "Treatment of Facial Ageing with Ozone Therapy: Clinical Case Report"

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The method used by the authors cannot be reproduced:

- they don't say how many areas they drew.
- they don't say how many injection points they used in each area and why they did it so.
- page 2: "...and home care guidelines, are provided in Table 1", but in Table 1 there is no reference to home care.
- the concentration used is not justified until the discussion, assuming they were inspired by Bas and Yula (2018) paper.
- the other paper referred to in the discussion section - Makita's one - lacks useful technical details, such as volume and ozone concentration.
- after the ozone injections, ozonated oil is applied through a massage. Which ozone oil? The serum from Pkilozon.

When the methodology cannot be reproduced by other authors, the work is useless.
