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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

- 1. The sample size is too small to reach the statistic power, therefore the conculsion cannot be generalized.
- 2. There's no control stimuli for comparision. Besides, what's the differences between the spiciness perception and other taste perception, such as sweet, or bitter?
- 3. The influence of other factors on the results was not excluded, such as the sensitivity to pain and the thermal sensitivity, individual liking of the capsaicine et al.
