It has been seen that the literature and references are old. It would be better to explain the latest situation in Ethiopia with more current literature and information.

It is stated that 10% of the total population was used for the preliminary survey test. It is not fully understood why this is the case.

Since a period such as age 5 was chosen, memory bias may affect the results. This was not mentioned.

In the findings section, children are classified as vaccinated or unvaccinated. For such classifications, definitions need to be fully provided.

It would be good to redesign the study taking all of these into consideration.
