1. How you estimated the number of cases by 2029
2. What technique was used to identify the isolated strain?
3. Was there not a culture of valve removal?
4. We don't see in the case report any study of the antibiotic sensitivity of the isolated strain
5. There is a repetition: "AU is a Gram-positive, microaerophilic, catalase-negative, alpha-hemolytic coccus which grows predominantly in tetrads and clusters."
