The authors' attempt is appreciated as the topic is interesting, but the research is not well done. I propose some suggestions for authors to improve their work:

- 1. it is important the presentation of the work, your article has a lot of lack of homogeneity, for example in the citation in the text or in the references, you should take this into account for the future.
- 2. The introduction is not good, it must comply with the minimum for an introduction of academic works, such as motivation, justification, objectives, methods, results and originality of the work.
- 3. Literature review does not justify the choice of the topic.
- 4. the research questions are not clear (I don't see that they are important either). Please review other research papers that use similar methodology and see how to improve this part.
- 5. the results are not analysed (the discussion is missing), nor are there any conclusions from the authors and the implications.
