This topic is both intriguing and timely. The manuscript is well-crafted, but there are areas where scientific rigor could be strengthened. The introduction and background effectively set the stage, yet emphasizing the necessity of replicating research, particularly in comparison to prior studies, could enhance clarity.

In the methods section, providing additional details about the cancer patient population at the specific hospital and contextual information would facilitate comprehension. Furthermore, a more thorough explanation of data protection and storage protocols is warranted. Consulting a statistician to ensure proper presentation of tables in APA style is advisable. While the manuscript mentions the use of Paired t-tests, chi-square tests, and ANOVA for data analysis, the results of these analyses are not readily apparent.

The discussion adeptly integrates findings from studies conducted in other countries to support the study's outcomes. Limitations should focus on the generalization of results and the sampling methodology. Including a future research plan based on the current findings could infuse optimism into the research narrative.
