In addition to that actual equations can be added with equation numbers. The equation numbers also can also be referred in the following text.

2. A link for demo video of using the tool Curvenote can be added which might be useful for new researchers.

Other minor issues are,

1. Mixed quotes (single quotes and double quotes) have been used. Either single quote or double quotes can be used throughout the paper.

2. Font size in Figure 12 is larger than other images. It should be uniform in all images.

3. Figure 7 caption should be corrected. HOw to How.
