

Review of: "A Review of the Processes and Procedures of Road Traffic Accident Mortality Data Collection in Zambia"

This is a well-written manuscript describing improvements needed with regard to the data on road traffic injuries in Zambia. The conclusion has been well linked with the results. The need for a "multi-sectoral approach" has also been noted in India (Menon, *et al.*, 2010). However, apart from the good work, there are a few areas that need editorial/typographical improvements as follows:

1. Introduction

a. First paragraph:

- i. Eighth line replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.
- ii. Ninth and tenth lines replace "low- and middle- income countries" with the abbreviation LMICs.

b. Third paragraph:

i. First line - replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.

c. Fifth paragraph:

i. Second line – replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.

d. Sixth paragraph:

- i. First line replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.
- ii. Twelfth line replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.
- iii. Thirteenth line replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.

e. Eighth paragraph:

- i. First and second lines replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.
- ii. Fifth line replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.

f. Ninth paragraph:

- i. First line replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.
- ii. Third line (two places) replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.



g. Tenth paragraph:

- i. Third line replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.
- ii. Seventh line replace "road traffic crashes" with the abbreviation RTCs.

h. Eleventh paragraph:

i. Fourth and fifth lines - replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.

1. Methodology

- a. First paragraph
 - i. Second line replace "road traffic crash (RTC)" with the abbreviation RTC.
- b. 2.2 Comprehensive Review and Analysis
 - i. Third line EDIT "levels" to be levels.

2. Findings

- a. 3.1 Zambia Police
 - i. Sixth bullet: second and third lines replace "road traffic crashes (RTCs)" with the abbreviation RTCs;
 - ii. Sixth bullet: Fifth line replace "Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS)" with the abbreviation CRVS.
- b. 3.3 Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS)
 - i. Third line replace "Department of National Registration, Passports and Citizenship" with the abbreviation DNRPC.

 - i. First line replace "Department of National Registration, Passport and Citizenship" with the abbreviation DNRPC.
 - ii. First line replace "Ministry of Home Affairs" with the abbreviation MOHA.
 - iii. Second line replace "Civil Registration and Vital Statistics" with the abbreviation CRVS.
 - iv. Thirteenth line replace "Road Traffic Crash" with the abbreviation RTC.
- b. 4.4 RTC Data Collection Processes and Procedures Evaluation Matrix



i. First line – replace "road traffic collision (RTC)" with the abbreviation RTC.

4. 6. Recommendations

a. Last paragraph – sixth line: replace "road traffic crash" with the abbreviation RTC.
