- Some of the stated applications were already a standard in some hospitals, suche as online multidisciplinary meetings
  to discuss complex cases, virtual intervies, or teleconsultations. It would be interesting to analyze how the impact of the
  pandemic on an already existing pratice.
- Despite all the renown advantages of telemedicine, the lack of face to face sessions come with a series of drawbacks
  which have fueled a rising complaint. I advise to esplore also the negativa impact of tele-education,.
- The reason for this manuscript is not well motivated. It should be stated better to give a sense of purpose and a scientific weigth to the paper
