The research paper is very extensively drafted, considering the minute details of the topic. There are few suggestions that needs to be incorporated:

- 1. There is no Literature Review as a heading, all the papers referred are mentioned under the Introduction heading. Literature Review should be a different heading as the literature of various papers.
- 2. The papers reviewed are not in proper format, citation is missing.
- 3. Method chapter has been extensively drafted, but lack of a small block diagram or the flow chart showing the actual flow of work.
- 4. Round One data was analyzed using both inductive analysis and content analysis as mentioned by authors, but clarity about inductive analysis and content analysis is required.
- 5. In Result chapter, authors have calculated mean and Interquartile Range in Round two and Round three for different IoT behavior sub-domains, but the formula for the above calculation is missing.
- 6. Little clarity is required in the manuscript, as in few areas the purpose behind the research work and the method adopted is not clear.

Overall paper is very good, I suggest acceptance with above suggestions
