- 3.) The analysis of the capacity of the resilience in urban areas is an important question, but it would be useful to describe and define what type of urban environment will be in the focus (innert zones, or outskirt areas or both)
- 4.) Probably it would be useful to demonstarte the capacity of the resilience of the different urban areas based on case studies
- 5.) How does the author define the urban resilience?
