Some minor Comments

Methodology:

Needs to describe the sampling techniques used to recruit study participants, i.e., whether the study participants were enrolled conveniently as they were found in the household and met the criteria or otherwise. Also, the author did not describe the consent process, whether the participants were informed about the importance of the study and their rights, and then signed the consent form before enrollment in the study. The author needs also to describe the details on statistical analysis in detail; for example, the data were analyzed by univariate and multivariate analysis.

Results:

The author is advised to summarize predictors in tables so that it will be easy for the reader to follow.
