The Role Of The Apostle Paul's Evangelism Based On The Apostle's Story Of The Pentecostal Church In Growth In The Gedongkuning Church, Yogyakarta Indonesia

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This scientific work describes and analyzes evangelism according to the Acts of the Apostles on the growth of the Pentecostal church congregation in Indonesia, Gedong Kuning, Yogyakarta. Findings, the researchers used the data obtained from the three hypotheses above by testing them out. With results like this: First, the variables X1 to Y with the value obtained is 0.738 where the number of respondents is 50. Based on the r table where it is known that for N = 50 r the number is 0.361. From the calculation, it is known that the r table is 0.738 and 0361 is r table. The hypothesis is accepted that there is an influence of the role of evangelism with mortgages. on the growth of the Yogyakarta Gedongkuning Pentecostal church. Based on the results of the calculation of the correlation coefficient between the X1 variable and the Y variable, it is 0.738 or 22, 7% categorized in the interpretation of the correlation coefficient is included in the low category which has a significant effect. Second, the independent variable and the dependent variable Y X2 are obtained with a value of 0.750 where the number of respondents is 50. Based on the calculation of the correlation coefficient between the X2 variable and the Y variable, it is 36% which when considered in the standard guidelines for interpretation of the correlation coefficient is included in the low category which has a significant effect. Third, the results of the multiple linear regression test obtained a table of R values (correlation) for the role of evangelism based on mortgages of 35.2%. Based on the calculation of the correlation coefficient between the X2 variable and the Y variable, it is 36% which, when considered in the standard guidelines for interpretation of the correlation coefficient, is included in the low category which has a significant effect. Third, the results of the multiple linear regression test obtained a table

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Introduction

In Matthew 16:18 it is written "And I also say to you, You are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." The rock is the Self and Work of the Lord Jesus Christ where Christ's Work consists of: incarnation, birth, life, ministry, crucifixion, death, resurrection, and ascension to heaven. All of these works are aimed at obtaining members of His congregation, namely people who repent of their sins after the preaching of the Gospel.

In the history of the church, the Apostle Paul was the person who most knew and became a faithful follower of the Lord Jesus. His whole life and ministry is an example of his faithfulness to follow Christ. The Apostle Paul was greatly strengthened by the statements in the Bible and believed completely in "This is what I proclaim in my Gospel." In I Corinthians 11:1 it is also written, "Become a follower of me, just as I have also become a follower of Christ.

So the word of God spread more and more and more people heard. Barnabas and Saul returned from Jerusalem, after they had finished their ministry. They also brought John who was also called Mark. At that time in the church at Antioch there were several prophets and teachers, namely: Barnabas and Simeon who was called Niger, and Luke the Cyrene, and Menahem who was brought up with the regional king Herod, and Saul. One day while they were worshipping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said: "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work which I have appointed for them." So they fasted and prayed, and having laid hands on them, they let them go. Prompted by the Holy Spirit, Barnabas and Saul left for Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus. It is explained here that the evangelism of

Barnabas and Saul grew rapidly and the result was that many souls were won. They also brought John who was called Mark, Barnabas, Simeon who was also called Niger, Menahem and Lukius as the fruit of their ministry. This proves that the preaching of the gospel carried out by Barnabas and Saul not only won many souls for the Lord but also won many souls for God's work which is very necessary for the expansion of the kingdom of God. This is where the role of evangelism on the growth of the church at that time showed its results.

Jusuf BS in his book Church Growth Papers wrote as follows:

The servant of God as a leader in the church, and church bodies, must conform himself to the word of God, so that he becomes a blessing to God's people. Although many of God's people do not understand the curse they receive is partly from the punishment of their leaders, leaders must not live carelessly. Because God himself will hold him accountable. So the personality of a good or bad servant of God is related to the growth of the church.

The pre-mission period is a time that needs to be passed by an evangelist. A missionary before engaging directly in preaching the gospel needs to go through a period of preparation. First, the disciples of Jesus did not automatically become disciples. The disciples entered the summoned phase. The process of summoning the disciples in a different way. Likewise students come from different social professions. In general, the students have different backgrounds. Peter was called from a fisherman. Matthew was called from a tax collector. In addition to a student must know about the vocation, then the second thing a student who will become a evangelist needs to receive learning. The Disciples did not become evangelists (fishers of men) on their own initiative or study, but Jesus taught the disciples to be able to do the work of preaching the gospel. It is not enough to prepare as a disciple by studying academically to preach the gospel. The help and guidance of the Holy Ghost is needed to properly fulfill the work of preaching the gospel. Matthew 4:19 records that: Jesus said to them, "Come, follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." In addition to theoretical preparation, Jesus taught the apostles by living with Jesus. There was no one there who could give him information about God and His saving work. Perhaps this new convert went to Arabia to be alone with God and to ponder deeply the implications of the Bible. There is no need to assume that all aspects of truth were given in the mind of the apostle when he was converted. From Arabia Paul returned to Damascus. This coincidental mention confirms the information from [Acts 9:3](#) that his conversion took place near that city. Everett F Pfeiffer, Charles F; Harrison, ed., Wycliffe Bible Commentary Volume 3. The Wycliffe Bible Commentary, 4th ed. (Unfortunately: Wheat Mas, 2013). Related to this, the importance of a present-day evangelist when being prepared, then the person concerned needs to be equipped both academically and by exemplary life.

Writing method

The research method used to discuss this research is a quantitative method with a hermeneutic strategy. Hermeneutic strategy is used in this study to examine and understand the meaning of the role of evangelism contained in the Acts of the Apostles about the Mission of the Apostle Paul. Hermeneutics or word meaning is closely related to understanding. F Budi Hardiman, The Art of Understanding: Hermeneutics, 2015. The word hermeneutics in general is a process that is theoretically and methodologically in understanding the meaning contained in a sign or symbol used in written communication or oral communication (Hardiman, 2015).

Results and Discussion

A well-prepared person may be sent according to local church regulations. This has been done by the western church by sending missionaries to preach the gospel in all corners of the archipelago. As a result, until now there have been many church synod organizations in Indonesia. The churches in Indonesia today are sending Indonesians to carry out the preaching of the Gospel in various cities in the world.

The assignment becomes an important mandate to reach out to souls. The church today needs people who are willing to go out of their way to see fields that are turning yellow and ready to be reaped. The church today needs people who are ready and say: Here I am, send me. The church today needs to realize that the existence of the church in Indonesia is facing a very concerning change. The areas that have been Christian enclaves are currently facing a dilemma that is not considered a dilemma. The areas in the interior of Papua and East Nusa Tenggara need the attention of people who are willing and willing to say: "Here I am, send me."

Reporting is directly related to the actions that will be carried out by the envoy. The New Testament gives the understanding that evangelists are people who 'preach the good news' (the Greek verb euangelizomai; the form of this term in the New Testament echoes the Hebrew words mevasser, mevasseret, in [Isaiah 40:9; 52:7](#)). This verb is used frequently in the New Testament, and is applied to God ([Galatians 3:8](#)), to the Lord Jesus ([Luke 20:1](#)), to ordinary church members ([Acts 8:4](#)), as well as to the apostles on their evangelistic journey. The Greek noun meaning 'evangelist' occurs only three times in the New Testament. Timothy in [2 Timothy 4:5](#) exhorted Paul to do the work of an evangelist; that is, to announce the facts of the good news. Timothy had accompanied Paul several times on his evangelistic journeys. But from the instructions given to Timothy in the two letters addressed to him, it is clear that his work when Paul wrote to him was primarily local and pastoral. That Timothy was commanded to do the work of an evangelist. This shows that the evangelist can also be a pastor and teacher. In [Acts 21:8](#) Philip is described as 'the evangelist'. Philip was chosen as one of the seven insiders [Acts 6](#), and after Stephen's death, he played an important role in evangelism in areas where the gospel had not yet been preached (eg. [Acts 8:5, 12, 35, 40](#)). Although Philip was an evangelist, Philip was not among the apostles ([Acts 8:14](#)). A similar distinction is made in the case of Timothy and the apostle Paul in [2 Corinthians 1:1](#) and [Colossians 1:1](#). Although the apostles were evangelists, all evangelists were not apostles. This distinction is emphasized in [Ephesians 4:11](#), there the office of 'evangelist' is called after apostles and prophets, before pastors and teachers. Based on this verse it is clear, that the gift of evangelism in the church is a special gift. DJ Douglas, JD; Hillyer, N; Bruce, FF; Guthrie, D; Millard, AR; Packer, JI; Wiseman, ed., Today's Bible Encyclopedia Volume 1 AL (Jakarta: Bina Kasih Communication Foundation, 2007), 184.

The Church of today can promote mission development in various areas of human life. It is unfortunate that the church is sometimes complicit in the shackles of evangelists. M Kace's sentence has been

Prosecutors gave their demands after the presence of 48 expert witnesses. One of the expert witnesses was a state official as well as a church official. The expert witness gave testimony that some Christians considered unfair. The church today needs to nurture evangelists so that evangelists are strong in the face of injustice.

Listening

The preaching of the gospel needs to be heard continuously. Paul experienced the experience of hearing the news of the gospel of Jesus Christ and His resurrection in the city of Athens (Acts 17:20). The word listen to us is a translation of the word *eisfereis eis tas akoas hemon* Hasan (Indonesian Bible Institute) Sutanto, Greek-Indonesian Interlinear New Testament and New Testament Concordance (PBIK) (Bogor: Indonesian Bible Institute, 2004), 733.. If translated literally means you brought into our ears. This shows that the word listen means continuous news that causes a response from the listener. The duty and responsibility of an evangelist is to speak the Word of God continuously. Sooner or later there must be a response from the listeners who hear the preaching of the word. This is important for the church today in determining the preacher. Before sending a missionary, the church needs to know whether the missionary will be militant in proclaiming the gospel message to the people he will meet. So that by constantly listening to the news of the gospel of the Lord Jesus and sooner or later there will be a response from people who hear the news.

Convincing

The responsibility of a person who is a missionary is to ensure the preaching of the gospel he preaches to the listeners. One of the missions of the Apostle Paul for believers in Rome is that they believe John Piper, Make All Nations Rejoice God's Supremacy in Mission, 2003.. This is related to the preaching of the gospel that is heard, it is hoped that there will be a response from the listeners. Good listener responses don't happen automatically. Of course, it is a process until the listener wants to believe in the news. The Apostle Paul had experience of his responsibility to convince listeners who heard his preaching. Acts 19:8b. *kai peithoon ta peri tes basileias tous Theou* Sutanto, Greek-Indonesian Interlinear New Testament and New Testament Concordance (PBIK), 742. if this word is translated literally means then trying to convince them of the kingdom of God. This shows that the Apostle Paul did not just preach, hear the preaching of

the gospel of Jesus Christ. But the Apostle Paul tried to discuss and convince his listeners about the preaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

One of the things that is emphasized in a missionary is that his preaching needs to be continuously talked about and it is also necessary to convince the audience of the gospel message. Today's evangelists can increase today's mission so that the church can grow because of the conversion of new people who have heard the message of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Accompany the Listener to Exclaim

The task of a missionary is not just to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ. However, they continue to listen, convince and accompany the listeners to make the decision to call out. It must be acknowledged that this is not an easy job. But it is the missionary's job to accompany his listeners. Paul implicitly has the assistance to mature spiritually from the ministers around him. Acts 19:1-12 Dr. Luke wrote of Paul's ministry experience that those who had heard the preaching of the gospel were not left to find the answers on their own. Paul accompanies those who have given themselves to baptism. Paul lived with the new converts for two years (Acts 19:9).

Post-mission Period

The church today has an ongoing task of nurturing new converts. Paul had great experience in preaching the gospel. But Paul also had a great responsibility to nurture the new converts by delegating the task of caring for the young people who had been with Paul. Timothy was a young man who became a friend of the Apostle Paul's ministry Leon Xavier Dufour, Encyclopedia of the New Testament (Yogyakarta: Kanisius, 1990), 550.. Paul delegated the task to Timothy. The specific assignment can be seen in 1 Timothy 1:18-20. Utley, Letters 1 & 2 Timothy And Titus. This task was specifically given by Paul to Timothy David J. Bosch, Transformation of Christian Missions History of Missionary Theology That Changes and Changes (Jakarta: BPK Gunung Mulia, 2012), 206. to follow up his evangelistic ministry in Ephesus. The delegation of tasks was also given by Paul to other co-workers.

Research result

Research Instrument Test

After the research data processing has been described, the instrument trial is then held. This instrument trial was conducted on 53 members of the Pentecostal Church in Indonesia, GedongKuning, Yogyakarta. After the questionnaires were answered and collected, the validity and reliability tests were carried out.

Validity test is used to see the value of the correlation coefficient (r). In this study, the instrument is declared valid if the correlation value (r) obtained from the table coefficient, the critical value r table is 0.361. From the results of the initial calculation, it can be seen that all questions are stated as valid for variables X_1 , X_2 and Y with the following results:

From the results above, it can be seen that not all statements submitted received a positive response from the GpdI Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta, so the results obtained were not all declared valid. Therefore, the author deletes invalid statements, continuing will affect the test results. In the implementation of the research trial, the author carried out a try out to the congregation as many as 59 people, while those who were invalid were 7 so that the number of people studied were 52 people.

Furthermore, a reliable test is carried out to determine whether the instrument of a research is proven reliable to be used in the study. A research instrument is said to be reliable if a questionnaire is consistent

when used to measure the same sample at different times or is also consistent when used to measure the same characteristics at the same time on different samples. In determining the variables, correlation techniques are used with the product moment correlation formula with the solution using the help of the SPSS 19 program for windows.

The author's reliability test can be carried out on each variable, both the role of evangelism according to KPR, evangelism according to KPR and the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta.

From the results of the reliability test on the growth variable of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation (Y) above, it can be stated that the Y variable has a value of 0.733.

The fact that the test results obtained by the table average 95%, this shows that all items are declared reliable because the test > table ($0.733 > 0.361$). Therefore, the reliability of the X2 variable is declared significant or reliable.

From the results of validity and reliability testing, it can be seen through the recapitulation results above that the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation, obtained the results that the variables X1, X2 and Y showed high reliability. It is proven that all test values > table or by looking at the level are significant, because all numbers are above 0.05.

Descriptive Statistical Analysis

This study uses descriptive statistical analysis to explain the description of the conditions of each variable consisting of the three research variables, namely:

Descriptive statistical data in the table above shows the results of processing with a total of 53 respondents or the data of research subjects that have been declared valid.

The data shows that the teaching role variable according to KPR (X) has an average value (mean) of 82.30, a median value of 83.00. The standard deviation of the data from the average is 4.405 while the distance or range between the lowest data and the highest data is 18, the minimum value is 74 and the maximum value is 92 with a total (sum) of 4362.

These data indicate that the variable Role of Evangelism according to KPR (X) has an average value (mean) of 75.23, a median value of 76.00. The standard deviation of the data from the average is 4.195 while the distance or range between the lowest data and the highest data is 17, the minimum value is 66 and the maximum value is 83 with a sum of 3987.

The data shows that the variable Growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta Congregation (Y) has an average value (mean) of 63.68, a median value of 63.00. The standard deviation of the data from the average is 3.435 while the distance or range between the lowest data and the highest data is 12, the minimum value is 58 and the maximum value is 70 with a sum of 3375.

Normality test

Normality test is intended to see whether the data has been distributed normally. For this purpose, the Lilliefors (Kolmogorov Smirnov) normality test was used. Through SPSS 19, the results are shown in the table below.

From the table above in the normality test, it is known that the Teaching Role variable according to KPR (X) has the Asymp.Sig value from the Kolmogorov-Smirnov test results is 0.541. Because the Asymp.Sig value obtained is greater than 0.05 from the number of respondents or $\text{Sig.}=0.541 > 0.279$, the data distribution for the variable (X) is declared to be normally distributed.

From the data above, it can also be seen that the variable Role of Evangelism according to KPR (X) has an Asymp.Sig value from the results of the Kormogorov-Smirnov test, which is 0.006. Because the Asymp.Sig value obtained is greater than 0.05 from the number of respondents or $\text{sig.}=0.006 > 0.279$, then the data distribution for the variable (X) is declared not normally distributed.

Meanwhile, from the results above, it can also be seen that the variable growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation (Y) has an Asymp.Sig value from the Kolmogorov-Smirnov test results, which is 0.069. Because the Asymp.Sig value obtained is greater than 0.05 from the number of respondents or $\text{sig.}=0.069 < 0.279$, then the data distribution for the variable (Y) is declared not normally distributed.

Linearity Test

X1 Linearity Test Against Y

The linearity test of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta.

From the table above, it was found that the linearity test results showed that the significant value for linearity was 0.001. Because the significant value is less than 0.05 ($0.001 < 0.05$), it can be concluded that there is a significant or linear relationship between the role of Evangelism according to KPR (X) and the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta (Y).

The first table shows the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation that was processed

The second table displays the R value which is a symbol of the correlation coefficient value in the results above the correlation value is 0.477. This value can be interpreted that the relationship between the two research variables is in the low category but there is still a relationship. Through this table also obtained the R Square value or the coefficient of determination (KD) which shows how much regression is obtained in the independent variable and the dependent variable. The KD value obtained is 0.227 which can be interpreted that the independent variable of the role of evangelism according to KPR (X) has a contribution effect of 22.7% on the variable growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation (Y)

The third table is used to determine the level of significance or linearity of the regression. the criteria can be determined based on the significant value test (Sig). based on the third table, obtained the value of Sig. = 0.000 which means <Criterion significant (0.05), thus the linear regression equation based on the research data above between the relationship between the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPDI Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta is Significant

X2 Regression Test Against Y

The first table shows the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the Gpdi Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation which is processed.

The second table displays the R value which is a symbol of the correlation coefficient value. In the above results the correlation value is 0.600. This value can be interpreted that the relationship between the two research variables is in the low category but there is still a relationship. Through this table also obtained

the value of R Square or coefficient of determination (KD) which shows how much regression is obtained in the independent variable and the dependent variable. The KD value obtained is 0.360 which can be interpreted that the independent variable The Role of Evangelism according to KPR (X) has a contribution effect of 36% on the variable growth of the Gpdi Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation (Y)

The third table is used to determine the level of significance or linearity of the regression. The criteria can be determined based on the significance value test (Sig). Based on the third table, obtained the value of Sig. = 0.000 which means < significant criteria (0.05), thus the linear regression equation based on the research data above between the relationship between the variables of the role of Evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the Gpdi Gedongkuning congregation in Yogyakarta is significant.

The first table shows the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the Gpdi Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation that is processed.

The second table displays the R value which is a symbol of the correlation coefficient value. In the above results the correlation value is 0.614. This value can be interpreted that the relationship between the two research variables is in the high category. Through this table also obtained R Square value of 0.377 and Adjusted R Square of 0.352 which can be interpreted that the independent variable The Role of Evangelism according to KPR has a contribution effect of 37.7% on the variable growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation.

The third table is used to determine the level of significance or linearity of the regression. The criteria can be determined based on the significant value test (Sig). Based on the third table, the value of Sig. = 0.000 is obtained, which means < significant criteria (0.05), thus the linear regression equation based on the research data above between the relationship between the variable Role of Evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation is significant.

Hypothesis testing

This study has 3 hypotheses that need to be tested. Based on the framework of thinking that has been proposed in chapter II, several research hypotheses are formulated, as follows:

1. It is suspected that there is a significant influence between the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GP congregation in Gedongkuning Yogyakarta, which is significant.

2. It is suspected that there is a significant influence between the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation, which is significant.
3. It is suspected that there is a significant influence between the variables of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation, which is significant.

This hypothesis test is done by observing several things, such as: normality test analysis, linear test analysis, simple regression analysis and multiple regression analysis. Significant regression test through the test, linear equations through the Anova table. Correlation test and linear regression test were used to determine whether there was a relationship and how high the relationship was between the two variables. Simple linear regression test was used to determine the contribution and significance of the effect. The test will produce a regression coefficient that is the magnitude of the relationship between variables globally. In addition, the coefficient of determination is also generated, namely the magnitude of the relationship X_1 , X_2 and Y based on the variance which is often called a pure relationship.

Furthermore, in order to test the significant level, the study made an interpretation of the results of hypothesis testing. The interpretation obtained by comparing the regression coefficient (r_0) with the critical regression price (r_1) with a significant level of 5% (0.05).

Some provisions that need to be considered, among others:

1. If the regression coefficient value is greater than or equal to the critical regression price (r_1) is 0.05 (r_0), then the proposed hypothesis is significant.
2. If the regression coefficient is less than or equal to the critical value (r_1) is 0.054 (r_0), then the proposed hypothesis is not significant.

The criteria used to determine the degree of relationship that occurs between the influence variable and the affected variable are as follows:

1. 0.9 to 1.0 Very high regression
2. 0.7 to 0.9 High regression
3. 0.4 to 0.7 Moderate regression
4. 0.2 to 0.4 Low regression still has a relationship
5. 0.0 to 0.2 Very low regression

The results of hypothesis testing 1,2, and 3 are contained in the simple and multiple regression tables. The hypothesis will be tested by regression analysis between each variable (X1) to variable Y, variable (X2) to variable Y, variable (X1 and X2) to variable Y, from SPSS 19.00 for windows.

Hypothesis Test Results

Hypothesis test 1: The relationship between X1 and Y. variables

Hypothesis 1 in this study states: "It is suspected that there is an influence of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation."

From the simple linear regression table X1 against Y, it can be explained that the significance value is $0.000 < 0.05$. Terms of significance of a variable if $r \text{ table} < r \text{ test}$. If you look at the table, it can be said that the results of the analysis show that the test (t count) is 0.227. If it is related to the table with $N = 50$ respondents, $r \text{ table}$ is 0.279, then the result is $t \text{ test} < t \text{ table}$ ($0.227 < 0.279$).

Thus it can be said that hypothesis 1 reads "There is no influence between the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation." in a low coefficient but there is still a relationship.

Hypothesis test 2: The relationship between X2 and Y. variables

Hypothesis 2 in this study states: "It is suspected that there is an influence of the role of evangelism according to KPR on the growth of the Yogyakarta GPdI congregation."

From the simple linear regression table X2 against Y, it can be explained that the significance value is $0.000 < 0.05$. The terms of the significance of a variable if $r \text{ table} < r \text{ test}$. If you look at the table, it can be said that the analysis shows that the t test (t count) is 0.360. If it is connected with t table with $N=50$ respondents $r \text{ table}$ is 0.279, then the result is $t \text{ test} > t \text{ table}$ ($0.360 > 0.279$).

Conclusion

Thus, it can be concluded through hypothesis 2 which reads "There is an influence of the role of Evangelism according to the Acts of the Apostles on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation." Based on the regression coefficients in the criteria above, it can be stated that the relationship between the role of evangelism according to KPR and the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation of 0.360 is classified as a low coefficient but there is still a relationship. Why is it low because in practice the role of teaching is higher than the role of evangelism. Based on hypothesis 3

in this study states: "It is suspected that there is an influence of the role of KPR evangelism on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation," From the simple linear regression table X2 against Y, it can be explained that the significance value is $0.000 < 0.05$. Terms of significance of a variable if $r_{table} < r_{test}$. If you look at the table, it can be said that the results of the analysis show that the t test (t count) is 0.352. If it is connected to the t table with N = 50 respondents, the r table is 0.279, then the result is $t_{test} > t_{table}$ ($0.352 > 0.279$).

Thus it can be said that hypothesis 3 reads "There is an influence of the role of evangelism together according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation." Based on the regression coefficient in the criteria above, it can be stated that the relationship between the role of evangelism together according to KPR on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation of 0.352 is classified as a low coefficient but there is still a relationship. Why is it low because the influence of X1's role is higher than X2's role, namely evangelism on the growth of the GPdI Gedongkuning Yogyakarta congregation.
