It should provide the research questions and hypothesis development. I think, that this literature review provides just the explanation of variables. This part should be primarily based on literature sources not older than 5 years and it is necessary to work with a greater number of literary sources.

Methodology

Authors declare "The percentage is then interpreted based on the interpretation of the mean score and percentage score according to Heir et al. (2010)". This literature source is missing in the part of References. Please check and compare the list of Reference with the literature sources in the paper. For me, the used method is not clear. The calculation of results is not clear. You should also present the information if the used data fulfilled the condition for using the stated method.

Results

This part should contribute to the explanation of the research problem, research questions, and hypothesis.

Conclusion

The part of the Discussion is partially stated in the part of the Conclusion, but this part is very weak. The focus of future research is missing. I recommend adding the part "Discussion".

It is not clear how the paper contributes to the theory and practice in the observed area.
