The article is an important addition in terms of subject and approach taken to answer the key question on the importance of education in addressing the challenges of digitalization and its role in using modern technologies to stimulate growth and better integration in the market. My first comment is about the possibility to expand the target groups to gather information to give credibility to findings. It may also be preferable to explore the views of young beneficiaries to assess their opinions on the need for better integration of education into the economic system. Finally, it should be noted that vocational training and practical experience play an important role in the transition from school to work, which requires practical skills that may not be available in the education system. Here, the role of the private sector is crucial in linking the results of the education system to market requirements.
