The author speaks about an ethnographic approach, but in the methodology is not clearly explained how this has been adopted in terms of observations and interaction, excluding interviews.

The names cited are real name of women? Is there not an issue of provacy.

Finally, I think that the author should declare also some limit of this study, for instance the fact to have not a comparison with data from other non-criminal tribes.
