2. Are there any good methods to prevent sarcopenia in the post-COVID era? These can be discussed in the manuscript.
3. Some insights and hypotheses for further research related to sarcopenia and COVID should be discussed at the end of the manuscript.
4. Language use such as "things get harder when we consider" can be very casual and informal for a scientific publication. There are also some spelling and minor grammar mistakes. Therefore, professional proofreading and language editing are recommended.
