- The abstract can be improved to reflect some of the plant's antimicrobial activity.
- The introductory part on diabetic foot ulcers should be removed as it has no correlation with the main text. It can be replaced with ethnobotanical information about the species.
- While there are a few mentions of some of its constituents, there is perhaps no mention of these constituents having antimicrobial activity. Constituents may also differ among the different species. I believe this should be mentioned.
- What about multi-drug resistant bacteria and acid-fast bacilli? Are there any activities? This can also be mentioned to make the review richer in content. This is so because most antimicrobials being developed are to fight drug resistance.
- Diagrams of some of these plant species can make the review richer.
- Grammatical errors should be addressed.
