Glaucoma is a complex disease, and the situation in secondary glaucoma is even more complicated. The prevalences of the underlying ethiologies of secondary glaucoma vary across populations. Neovascular glaucoma may not be the commonest cause of secondary glaucoma; instead, uveitis, pigment dispersion syndrome, and pseudoexfoliation may be the top causes in some populations.
