I would like to express that all components of the protocol are well written, and the methodology is presented in detail. This can help readers to be aware of the process. An important point is the omission of specific tags for PubMed, such as [tiab]. Additionally, it is necessary to include the search strategy for other databases mentioned in the methods section. In the PubMed search strategy, the general terms from the second component are not needed, and the total number of synonyms for COVID-19 was limited. Overall, it is essential that the PubMed search strategy consists of two components and is written under the supervision of a medical librarian specialist.
