

Review of: "Unravelling The Contributions Of The Nigerian Livestock And Other More Prominent Sectors In Mitigation Of Global Green House Gas (GHG)"

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The article is scholarly written and has potentials for impacts. However, the following observed areas require improvement to strengthen it.

In chapter one, some sweeping statements without basis or reference were observed in page 2, paragraph 1 and 2. Also, it is essential for the author to offer a conceptual explanations or clarifications of both the adaptation and mitigation strategies to afford a layman easy understanding and make the work more comprehensive.

In chapter two, submission and assertions made about the Nigeria's poverty under the sub-heading of "Bad Governance a Challenge" require being reference to validate the data as well as the data cited under cattle farms.

The chapter three, under material and methods needs further analysis of the age groups of youths proposed, their required academic qualifications as those without basic education may not be fitting to the proposal.

The fourth chapter cost estimates for mitigation seems practicable but may fall below estimate because of inflation, which is not provided for, and may affect both the cost and the projected profit. I suggest that it should be reviewed or given a second look.
