I appreciate your perspective on the COVID-19 review. There are some issues that could help readers better understand your manuscript. Firstly, the title of the study does not clearly convey the main objective. It seems that the review lacks a defined goal and instead reviews each section as desired by the authors.

Furthermore, the current review contains a lot of repetition, unnecessarily extending the length of the abstract and manuscript. Some well-known sentences could be omitted by the authors. Additionally, there are grammatical, editorial, and reference-related problems in the study.

A significant problem is the lack of coherence between paragraphs, without a practical concluding sentence to bridge them together. Moreover, the abstract and the manuscript do not align; for instance, the manuscript denies vertical transmission, while the abstract accepts it.

In conclusion, I suggest that you thoroughly revise the manuscript, ensuring a clear and coherent approach.
