- 1. The author should ask for the assistance of a proofreader, as there are some typographical and grammar mistakes that must be fixed.
- 2. The abstract is too short and needs modification; the abstract should contain objectives, methods/analysis, findings, and novelty.
- 3. The introduction is poorly written, as it does not properly refer to

previously (but latest) research. The author needs to carefully review the published literature, identify the breaches in the literature, and propose their approach to filling the gap.

- 4. A flowchart or table visualization should be constructed to ease the readers.
- 5. I would ask the author to discuss more about the present research.

- 6. Comparison charts should be presented in context to convince the readers.
- 7. Much more deep analysis and interpretation should be added for the results, which are missing.
- 8. It is suggested to organize the conclusion section much better.
- 9. Reduce the number of self-references but increase the number of the latest scientific articles.
- 10. Last but not least, the research theme must sound catchier and be specific, not only in a broad sense.
