Introduction:

This research topic cannot be resolved in the way as indicated by the Q&A presented in the main text. This issue should be addressed in a systematic review or meta-analysis. Additionally, few references and little explanation of the background of the study.

Methods:

There are few descriptions of methodologies and many unknowns. Therefore, the study is not reproducible. There is no mention of criteria regarding literature search. The results collected should be compared, but no statistical processing has been done.
