Positive Comments:

- 1. The output of the project is very promising.
- 2. The topic is very relevant.
- 3. The details presented in the study are enlightening.

Suggestions:

- The problem statement must be clearly presented in the abstract and introduction. SDG must be tied up with the
 problem stated in your study. The literature reviewed should preferably be from 2020 to the present. The global and
 local contexts should be coherently presented. It would be of best interest if the specific research objectives are
 included.
- 2. The research design should be a specific qualitative, quantitative, or mixed method type. Do not just state qualitative and quantitative. The selection criteria for study participants need to be clearly discussed. I think ethical considerations in the conduct of the study should be included in your discussion.
- 3. The results and discussion should reflect the ADDIE model. Some information is lacking or missing. How long is the period of implementation? The interpretation and implications of the results and findings are not tied up with the chosen model or the problem being addressed.
- 4. The conclusion needs to be more comprehensive to cover the significant discovery or findings of the study.
- 5. Some of the references are not traceable (e.g. missing DOI or URL)
